**Summary Report of
the 14th Ling Liang World-Wide Evangelistic Mission Association (LLWWEMA)**

We thank God for His grace, the 14th LLWWEMA (9.2010 – 9.2013) led by the Hong Kong District had been smoothly completed. There were three main objectives these years:-

1. Youth Mission

200 young people, from the USA, Indonesia, the Philippines and Hong Kong, participated in the International Youth Mission Camp held by LLWWEMA in June 2012. They worshipped, shared and team outings to experience cross-cultural mission together. More than 50 young persons committed themselves to serve our Lord during the devotional conference. Thus the LLWWEM — Hong Kong United Mission would follow up those in Hong Kong and set up a “devotion fellowship” for them.

2. Focus on Mission

After praying, we received from God that LLWWEMA has to concern for the Grace Ling Liang Church in India. Rev. Mok Hing Wan, Moses, Chairman, visited the church with Elders Paul Lam and Elder David Chan from the Bread of Life Church, Torrance in October 2011 to lead the gathering and expressed our concern about their development. Rev. Mok also invited 17 co-workers and disciples leaders to join a short-term mission to India in October 2012 and it I believe was accepted by our God. We thanked God for the significant progress in evangelistic missionaries and development of the local Hindi gospel ministry.

3. Arrangement for the Assembly

“Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!” (2 Corinthians 9:15)

The 14th General Assembly has been successfully held in Hong Kong from September 12 – 16, 2013. There were total 74 representatives and observers signed up for this Assembly including 30 from Indonesia, 6 - the USA, 2 - the Philippines, 1 - India, 1 - Kuching and 34 - Hong Kong. The theme was “Vision • Mission • Action”. It was the love of God that Rev. Morley Lee (came from the America), President of USA Care Ministries International, former General Secretary for CCOWE, could be our speaker. Rev. Lee delivered God’s messages according to our theme during the Open and Close Ceremonies of the LLWWEMA and the three Revival Meetings. His topics were “Renewal and Breakthrough”, “Devoted Prayers with One Accord” , “Moses and Vision”, “Moses and Mission” and “Moses and Action” respectively. We deeply believed members of Ling Liang had got sufficient spiritual food and known God’s will so that we could execute the vision of LLWWEMA - *“Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.” “Make disciples of all nations in the last time.”*

About 400 persons attended each of the two Revival Meetings while 280 from 10 churches attended the Youth Commissioning Revival Meeting and 22 young persons devoted themselves to preach or mission. May God uphold them.

The current LLWWEMA not only shared epoch-making messages with participants but also arranged sharings on mission work for different Ling Liang churches and the LLWWEM – Hong Kong United Mission.

LLWWEMA invited eight units, i.e. Ling Liang Church from the USA, the Philippines, India, Indonesia, Hong Kong, Kowloon, five member churches in the New Territories and LLWWEM – Hong Kong United Mission, to share their missionaries. They shared according to the guidelines of LLWWEMA as follows:-

- How had the vision of mission been developed?
- How did they plan?
- How did they motivate believers to participate in their missionaries?

This included operating expenses, manpower, prayer support, difficulties and challenges of missions and its success and the possibility to open to other churches.

Afterwards we had questions, sharings and intercession time altogether so as to enrich, share responsibility and learn from each other. Thanking God for our sharings were into focus, indepth and could be devoted by participants. LLWWEMA gathered all sharing information and burnt into CDs to representatives.

Discussions on ministries of LLWWEMA were one of our focuses these years. Topics included the contingency of ministries, youth mission, focus on mission and development of new ministries and review on the existing structure of LLWWEMA. In order to have all people involved and discussed in details, LLWWEMA divided attendees, according to their

regions and languages, into 7 groups to share general topics of LLWWEMA as well as its designated issues so as the ministries of LLWWEMA would be recognized , initiated, continued, be of one heart to participant and gloried our Lord. Thanks God – all went into discussions and acknowledged the contingency of focus of LLWWEMA on the youth mission and India ministries. The next President of LLWWEMA, by rotation, will be Rev. Netty Lintang, Indonesia. We thanked God for this preparation.


It was God's particular kindness and also the full support from Ling Liang churches and their members to have the conference to be held smoothly. We would like to thank:-

We pray that our Lord would personally reward each, establish what we did and revive LLWWEMA for His glory.

LLWWEMA experienced the rich supply from God that we got surplus of US\$27,000.00. Thanks God! As agreed by Rev. Netty Lintang and the 15th Committee of LLWWEMA, we donated US\$14,000 to Bread of Life Christian Church, Philippines for gospel ministries and Grace Ling Liang Church, India for their Hindi ministries (each US\$7,000) while the balance was left to the 15th LLWWEMA. Attached is a financial report of the 14th LLWWEMA for your perusal and we welcome for any enquiries. May our Lord be glorified!
